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Gentlemen of West London CC 1988-2025



The Gentlemen of West London Cricket Club (“The Gents”) was founded in 1988 by Mark Ashton and friends, most of whom had met at the University of York. There have been 719 games, excluding a 1993 T20 against Enterprise whose multi-coloured scorecard was annoyingly lost. Nor does the batting card survive from the second game, against East Harrow Cheetahs in 1988, though oddly the bowling card does. Otherwise records are complete as far as we know. This publication documents the exceptional: the cover picture shows J. Small (131*) and S. Kumar (74*) being clapped off by St Anne’s Allstars in June 2015 after posting the club’s highest stand of 212 in 22.5 overs, a recovery from the depths of 56-5.

A total of 450 players have made 7,898 appearances. The 21 members of the 100 Club have played 3,874 times; 24 have played 50-99 and there have been 170 singletons, 12 of whom neither batted nor bowled. When *Decade* was published in 1997 one could recall every guest but this is no longer possible. More than a third of the games took place at Victoria RG in Surbiton (133) and Old Tenisonians CC in Motspur Park (98), both venues at which cricket is sadly no longer played. Most matches were played in the 35-overs format.

Games have been played against 127 opponents at 114 venues. St. Anne’s Allstars (2002), Salix (2004) and Northfields (2009) are the longest-standing.

Summarised scorecards for each opponent and ground are shown in *GWLCC Results 1988-2025.xlsx* and *GWLCC Results 1.pdf* for you to search or pivot away to your heart’s content. Some errors may have eluded proofreading. The squad is keen-eyed on such matters, so please let us know if you find any.

Initials of forenames are supplied to distinguish between, for example, the five Joneses, eight Khans, 21 Patels and four Wrights who appear in the scorebooks.

The President’s Cup 1992-2001 was a T20 competition held on the Sunday before the August Bank Holiday. It was the brainchild of New Barbarian Weasels’ founder, the late W. Flack, and predated the first English professional T20 by 11 years. Three sides participated in a round-robin format.

The Bob Ashton Memorial Cup was contested 1990-2011 between Gents and West XI and retired when West XI amalgamated with Walthamstow Horizontals to form Judd Street Tigers, rebranded before the 2019 season as Winchmore Hill Tigers. *Derby Fever.pdf* (see website under *The Gent, Reviews and Records*) recalls this hard-fought, entertaining series.

The Pals League was contested 2002-2007. Gents, New Barbarian Weasels, 12 Angry Men, Urban Associates, Pak and, for one season, West XI participated. Since 2011 only friendlies have been played.

New Barbarian Weasels appear frequently in this publication. At their peak in the mid- to late-90s, the Home Office boys were one of the strongest teams on the circuit and certainly the best organised. Ernie Tattersdill (back row second from right) was an exceptional all-rounder, and in 1997 became the first opponent to score a 50 and take four wickets in one game.

Bill Flack, resplendent in bow tie and waistcoat (back row third from left) was the first captain and a fine cricketer and innovator (see p2 President's Cup). He would later play four times for the Gents, taking nine wickets with his off-breaks. To his left in the black blazer is Simon Lloyd.

From row far left is Ulsterman and glovesman Jim Patrick, two away from gentle giant Jeremy Best, who scored 103 against the Gents in 1991 and hit the ball as hard as any player can have done.

Weasels continue to this day. Those great gentlemen Bill Flack, Simon Lloyd and Ernie Tattersdill have since died.

Since the days of Frank Gallagher in the 1980s and early 1990s few scorecards have recorded every ball faced by a batsman. However, particularly brisk 50s and 100s have been reconstructed from the original scorebooks to confirm the records. On 28.4.13 Praveen Bocha hit the then-fastest Gents 50 off just 21 balls before ceding the record 20 minutes later to Gregg Cloete, who despite looking likely to give up the ghost to the cold at any moment clubbed his first 52 off only 16, facing just 27 balls in total for his 83. Later in 2013, Owais Khalid also went to 50 in 21 balls against Salix as did Srinivas Namilikonda against Crossbats in 2019. Sixes have only been included in the end-of-season statistical round-ups since 2009.
