Gentlemen of West London CC 1988-2020



The Gentlemen of West London Cricket Club was founded in 1988 by Mark Ashton. It has played 608 matches, excluding a 1993 T20 against Enterprise whose multi-coloured scorecard was annoyingly lost. Nor does the Gents' batting card survive from the second game, against East Harrow Cheetahs in 1988 though strangely the bowling card does. Otherwise records are complete. This publication records the exceptional, e.g. the cover picture shows Jonny Small (131*) and Sumit Kumar (74*) being clapped off by St Anne's Allstars after posting in June 2015 the club's highest stand of 212 in 22.5 overs, a recovery from the depths of 56-5. Initials of forenames are supplied where available, so the above are recorded as J. Small and S. Kumar.

Most games, 353, were in the 35-over format. There were 113 40-over matches, 70 timed, 43 T20 and 29 in outlier formats (10, 15, 16, 18, 25, 30, 32 and 38 overs). It is curious that in matches played to a conclusion the average runs scored in timed games, 259, was lower than in the 35- and 40-over formats (275 and 317). This might be explained by captains keeping on star bowlers for long spells, on often variable pitches. There were 391 players, of whom 40 played 50 times or more, making 4,523 appearances (68% of the total). Seventeen have joined the 100 Club of whom six played in 2020 including the Top 3, S. Patel, H. Patel and S. Snelling.

Guest appearances remain a source of fascination. One hundred and forty-six played only once of whom 31 did not bat and nine neither batted nor bowled. Teja narrowly failed to qualify for this dual lack of involvement; having not batted against Pak in 2019 he took a wicket with his only ball to win the match. Twenty-one singletons played in the first ten years, 54 in the second ten years, and 71 since 1998. One could recall every guest when *Decade* was published in 1997 but this is no longer possible.

The President's Cup **(1)** was a three-team (two-team in 2000 and 2001) T20 competition held 1992-2001 on the Sunday preceding the August Bank Holiday. The phrase Carnival of Cricket might have been invented for it. Hosts New Barbarian Weasels, the Gents, FC Chad and Urban Associates (once) participated. It was the brainchild of Weasels' founder W. Flack and predated the first English professional T20 game by 11 years.

The Bob Ashton Memorial Cup **(2)** was contested 1990-2011 between the Gents and West XI and retired when West XI amalgamated with Walthamstow Horizontals to form Judd Street Tigers, rebranded before the 2019 season as Winchmore Hill Tigers. *Derby Fever.pdf* (see website under *The Gent, Reviews and Records*) recalls this hard-fought, entertaining series.

The Pals League **(3)** was a three or four-team league contested 2002-2007. The Gents, New Barbarian Weasels, 12 Angry Men, Urban Associates, Pak and, for one season, West XI participated. Since the start of the 2012 season, all games have been friendlies. The 43-11 Cup against St Anne's Allstars has never been ratified by the Gents so does not appear above. It was named after their score on a Victoria RG minefield in 2004. Since 2011 it has been friendlies only.

Bill Flack, resplendent in bow tie and waistcoat (back row third from left) was the first captain and a fine cricketer and innovator (see P2 President's Cup). He would later play four times for the Gents, taking nine wickets with his off-breaks. To his left in the black blazer is the late Simon Lloyd.

From row far left is Ulsterman and glovesman Jim Patrick, two away from gentle giant Jeremy Best, who scored 103 against the Gents in 1991 and hit the ball as hard as any player can have done.

On 28.4.13 Praveen Bocha hit the then-fastest Gents 50 off just 21 balls before ceding the record 20 minutes later to Gregg Cloete (left), who despite looking likely to give up the ghost to the cold at any moment clubbed his first 52 off only 16, facing just 27 balls in total for his 83.

Sixes have only figured in the end-of-season statistical round-ups since 2009. Lall's total was the highest.
