## The scorecards

Individual performances of 20 or more runs and three or more wickets are shown. Initials are given to distinguish between the Khans, Patels, Wrights, etc. This helps to identify those who played as both Gents and opponents (e.g. N. Khan and C. Wright). Margins of victory by wickets show the number of wickets in hand. Thus, the Gents' 117 for 7 on 2 August 1992 is recorded as a win by 2 wickets because the chasing side only had 10 men. Individual performances are shown for each season according to club tradition – 100 runs, 10 wickets and five catches or stumpings.

The matches on 24/6/89 and 8/8/04 were abandoned because of injury. Other abandonments were because of rain. Games cancelled because of lack of a pitch (16/5/04), police advice (5/9/04), failure to raise a team (22/7/07, 26/8/12 and 9/6/13) or rain (all others) are shown below. Bricklayer's Arms, Judd Street Tigers and, back in the day, Exiles were particularly cursed. The Pacific cancellation was particularly tragic. The sides had never met, so the Fixture Secretary was surprised when he called Pacific in 1991 to arrange a new date, but was refused because the Gents were not up to their standard:
